"People are People the Whole World Over" was a year-long series that documented the ordinary, daily lives of twelve families across the globe. The Pratt family of Glidden, Iowa (population 1,146) represented the United States.


In advance of this program, participants will listen to a 45-minute podcast about the story at "Hit the Streets with Valerie Jardin."
